



Volunteers Policy

Volunteers are people who, unpaid and of their own free will, contribute their time, energy and skills to benefit the community.

The volunteer role is a gift relationship, binding only in honour, trust and mutual understanding.

This policy is intended to show Communigrow's commitment to volunteers.

Communigrow acknowledges that there are many varied benefits from volunteering and that each volunteer is unique.

There are a variety of activities for volunteers at Communigrow. Some examples are work on the field, publicity, assisting with workshops and open days.

There is no formal application process for volunteers but the Director of Operations holds a short 1:1 discussion which includes specific training needs and support.

The Director of Operations ensures that all volunteers are aware of Communigrow's Risk Management documents particularly our Health and Safety Policy.

Volunteer activities are co-ordinated by the Director of Operations.

Communigrow welcomes, and encourages, feedback and suggestions from volunteers
