What is a cookie?

Like most websites, Communigrow uses cookies.

A 'cookie' is a small file of letters and numbers, that is automatically stored on your device; computer, mobile phone or tablet when you visit our website. A cookie is a standard way of distinguishing you from other website users, to improve the performance of our website and provide us with information in relation to your website usage, that allows us to provide you with a better experience when you return to our website.

Types of cookies we use?

Strictly necessary cookies

These are cookies that are essential for you to be able to use and move around our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, provide website security or using a shopping cart.

Analytical/performance cookies

These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how they move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that you can find what you are looking for more easily.

Functionality cookies

These cookies are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

Targeting cookies

These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and any advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

MailChimp is a third-party data processor. The email address that you submit will be stored within their website's own database but not in any of our internal computer systems.
